Dear Margham Supporter,

Thank you for your faithful prayers and financial support of what God is doing in India through Margham. Your generosity is critical to meet the needs of the Mom Anita and Simon Children's Homes, pastors and many others reached through these ministries and servants.

From Pastor Arun: There is reason for us all to be joyfully Praising God. Corona-time Baptism is that reason. Some people get heaven's salvation in the threat of Corona. This way or that the Lord saves some or many before His return. Praise the Lord. It looks to me many more are going to accept Jesus this season. It makes our sad faces brighten up for a spiritual Joy. Alleluia. Can some of you, too, shout an Alleluia?

We usually baptize by immersion. Since the epidemic, new believers get into the empty tank and standing outside the tank the pastors pour over three pots full of water (Father, Son and Holy Spirit). We call it Corona Baptism. On June 19th two ladies and one young man took baptism. Let Baptisms happen continuously. The others in the group picture are the new team helping me in Door to Door ministry. These do not get any help. The local church shares the Sunday offerings with them. Alleluia.

From Sanda Amma at the Simon Children's Home: We greet you in the name of Jesus Christ our Savior. Hallelujah. Thank you for sending monthly help. We have received help for hungry elderly people and distributed rice to help to purchase fruits and vegetables. The total number is 35 at rate of Rupees 3000 (USD 40) each (rice, provisions, fruits, vegetables and for medicines). They are sending their thanks and love to you. With the help and permission of police, we helped them because we are in red zone. There are many positive cases in this village and the government is very alert to save the innocent people to avoid this pandemic from one another. By God's grace our children are doing well. But some children are suffering with boils due to overheat. We have given them treatment. Now they are better.

Some children have finished tailoring, mechanical and computer courses. After receiving help, they leave home and start to earn their livelihood and they will be witness to our Lord and proclaim the Word of God to unknown people.

CORONA STORIES

If not for this help of yours, we would have been just silent spectators with tears at this misery.

The young lady in the picture with her children is Maria. She is the daughter of one of our church members in Machilipatnam. On March 3rd, her husband, Vinay was admitted to the hospital with Corona and sadly died a week later. The family was quarantined, declared negative and discharged. Returning home, the people literally chased them away because they feared that they would infect the village. After much threat and confusion, this little family came to the Mom Anita Home for a interim refuge. We took care of them. Maria has no skill to earn money. We here in Mom Anita children will take care of the children and help her find a suitable job. Corona appears to have become a similar stigma as that of the caste system. Margham support has done great helping this family by way of food clothing, shelter etc. Praise God!

This is Mr. Rambabu. He was tested as Corona Positive and in quarantine for 28 days. At last, he was declared negative and discharged. As has become common, social stigma attacks were on him. His elderly mother rescued him and brought him to the home here for two weeks care and stay. Slowly the good food made him strong to face life come what may. He is still looked upon as an out caste. Margham is the only hope. He takes help from the Children Home every now and then. What a source of strength you are dear Margham. My words are not enough. May God help you understand these situations here.
